BOOKING BEN: HOW IT WORKS

1. Contact

Contact Ben's management.

3. Decision

After we have agreed on the date, time, location, the global subject and the price, we draw up a contract.

5. Briefing form

You will also receive a briefing form containing questions that will help Ben to prepare for your meeting.

7. Outline

Based on your conversation, Ben will send you his outline. That way, you know what to expect. You can also use this text to promote the session.

9. Session

Well before his session starts, Ben is on site. After he has finished his session, he will stay to answer oneon-one questions from participants.

2. Orientation

Together, look at what you want to achieve and what Ben can do. If there's a match, reserve a date on Ben's calendar.

4. Rider

With the contract, you will receive a 'rider' with useful information, for example about the technical requirements for audio and video.

6. Briefing

You and Ben will have a video-call of about one hour. The aim is to design a session that will really benefit your organization and the participants.

8. Last check

A few days before the session, Ben's management will contact you to talk through the details one more time.

10. Follow-up

The day after the session, you will be sent the handout of Ben's presentation materials.
